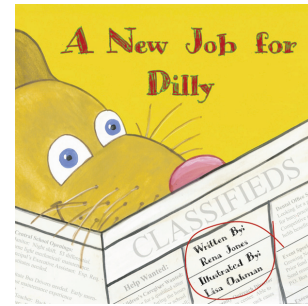

Dilly says ...

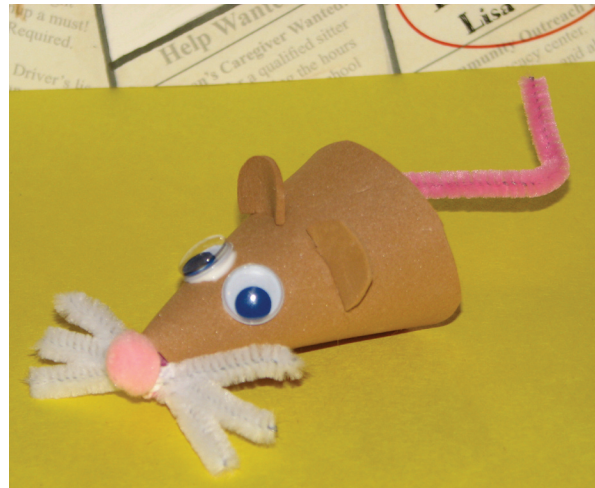
Make ME into a
finger puppet!



DILLY FINGER PUPPET

What You Need:

brown foam or construction paper
white & pink pipecleaner
2 googly eyes
small pink pompom
glue



Directions:

Cut a half circle from brown foam or construction paper. We traced a CD and cut the circle in half. Cut out 2 ears, shaped like mini-mushrooms. Roll into a cone and glue or staple to secure. Cut white pipecleaner into 1-1/2 inch pieces and twist in the middle to form Dilly's whiskers. Cut pink pipecleaner in half and twist around the center of the whiskers. Stick the end of the pink pipecleaner through the small hole of the cone. Trim tail to desired length. With adult help, cut 2 small slits in cone and place ears in the slits. Glue on googly eyes and pompom nose. Now you have your very own Dilly finger puppet!

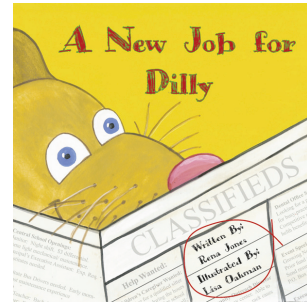

DILLY AND HIS CHRISTMAS PICKLE

What You Need:

felt scraps, brown, pink, green
2 googly eyes
small pompoms, pink and green
candy cane
glue



Directions:

Cut a teardrop shape from brown felt, about 6-inches long. With pink felt, cut out a bow-tie shape, about 4-inches long. Cut two 1-inch slits, about a half-inch apart in the middle of the brown piece. Slip ears through the slits, as shown. Glue on googly eyes. Glue on pink pompom for Dilly's nose. With green felt, cut out a pickle shape and glue on several green pompoms to represent the bumps on a pickle. Glue pickle onto Dilly's mouth. Stick the long end of the candy cane through the backside of Dilly's ears. Hang on your Christmas tree, or anywhere you like. Have fun!

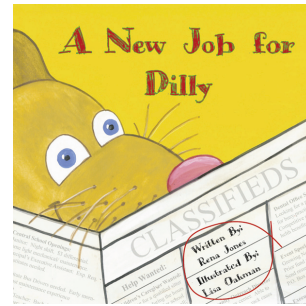

Dilly says ...

Make ME using
pipecleaners!



PIPECLEANER DILLY

What You Need:

3 brown pipecleaners
1 pink pipecleaner
2 googly eyes
glue



Directions:

To make Dilly's body, wrap a brown pipecleaner tightly around a pencil and then remove. Do the same with the second brown pipecleaner to make his head, but make it a little thicker on one end. Cut 1/3 off pink pipecleaner. Bend the smaller section in half and curl ends to make Dilly's ears. Curl the end of the other section of pink pipecleaner to make Dilly's nose. Push the straight end of the longer pink pipecleaner through Dilly's head, attach ears, and then add body piece. Curl up Dilly's tail. Cut the last brown pipecleaner in half and bend to make Dilly's legs and feet. Attach to body. Glue on googly eyes. Enjoy!
