## Uniform and Equipage Hurt's Battery:

In order of importance in case the recruit is to acquire them over time.  
The recruit has 18 months to fully outfit himself.

- Shell jacket:** Cadet or Richmond gray with solid red collar and cuffs, either CSA buttons or “A” artillery buttons
- Trousers:** Sky blue kersey wool (federal issue trousers)
- Kepi:** early war style with red band and dark blue crown, brass crossed cannons; period slouch hats also acceptable
- Shirt:** any shirt appropriate to the period
- Footgear:** either brogans or period boots
- Canteen:** any period canteen
- Suspenders:** period style, cotton, linen or leather
- Belt:** (Optional) black belt with CSA buckle
- Firearms:** (Optional): any correct sidearm and/or carbine

(Any member of the battery will be happy to assist with advice on uniforms, equipage and sources for same.)
