SCAGGS – Silas H. Scaggs. October 19, 1955 in a Salinas Hospital. A native of Monroe<sup>1</sup>, Louisiana. A resident of the Peninsula for 10 years. Age 55 [59<sup>2</sup>] years. A veteran of World War I with the Siberian Expedition Force. Husband of Mrs. Iva P. Scaggs of Seaside. Father of Tommy Scaggs of Salinas, Mrs. Roxie V. Lewis of San Diego, Mrs. Ollie Howell of Taft and Mrs. Sadie Good of Seaside. Brother of George Scaggs of Oklahoma, Guy Scaggs of [New] Mexico, Mrs. Parrelle [Paralee] Monroe of Longview, Washington, Mrs. Isabelle [Isabel] Peppers of Longview, Washington, Mrs. Dorey May [Dora Moye] of Oklahoma and Mrs. Eva Thomas of Oklahoma. Funeral services will be held Saturday, October 22 at 9:30 a.m. with Mr. G. T. Prince officiating. Interment Mission Memorial Park, Seaside<sup>3</sup>. Dorney and Farlinger in charge of funeral arrangements.

Notes. WWI was 1914-1918; he would have been about age 18 when the war started.
