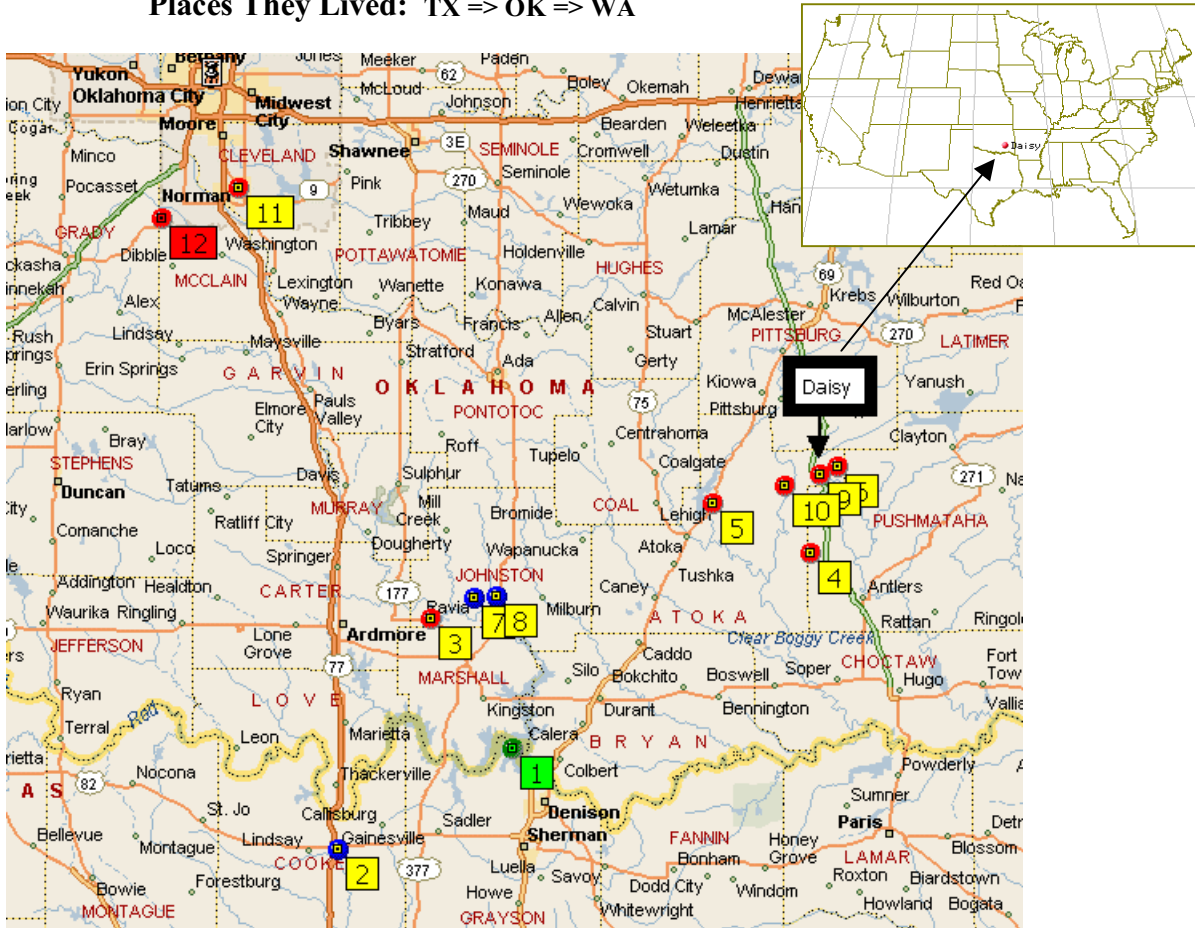


Places They Lived: TX => OK => WA



Legend: Joseph Ward (Joe) RENFRO; James Bascom SELBY; Lee R. RENFRO.

1. **Preston Bend, Grayson Co, TX.** Lee R. Renfro born here in 1868.
2. **Gainesville, Cooke Co. TX.** Bertha Selby born here in 1887, some siblings also born here.
3. **Mannsville, Johnston Co., OK.** Buried at Norton Cem. in Mannsville: Johnnie d.1898 & Ronnie d.1903 - children of Lee R. & Viola;. Lee's father, Joseph Ward (Joe) d.1904, Lee's half-brother John d.1917.
4. **Zoraya, Pushmataha Co, OK.** Aug 1905 Viola HUNT Renfro writes letter from Zoraya; May 1905 Balmer, dau. of Lee R. & Viola, is born in Zoraya.
5. **Stringtown, Atoka Co., OK.** Viola HUNT Renfro writes 3 letters from Stringtown bet. 1907? & 1909; Viola died here in July 1909; Lee's half-sister Mamie Jo RENFRO Evans lived here & her Evans in-laws.
6. **Goss, Atoka Co., OK.** Lee R. had a sawmill here. When it burnt he rebuilt in Daisy.
7. **Ravia, Johnston Co., OK.** Lee R. & Bertha married 8 Jan 1912 at the home of J.B. Selby of Ravia.
8. **Tishomingo, Johnston Co., OK.** J.B. Selby & Family. Maggie d.1921; James B. Selby d.1925; Mary Lou FLETCHER d.1936; Ludie d.1911-25. All 4 buried in Fillmore Cemetery. in Tishomingo.
9. **Daisy, Atoka Co., OK.** The "old home place" with the Cotton Gin where the Lee R. Renfro family lived from 1912 to late 1930s. Family Photo taken there about 1936.
10. **Redden, Atoka Co., OK.** From the "old home place" in Daisy they moved to Redden.
11. **Norman, Cleveland Co., OK.** From Redden they moved to Norman, on Lamar's old place; there 2-3 yrs.
12. **Blanchard, McClain Co., OK.** From Norman they moved to Blanchard; photos of Renfros with Henry's 1934 Ford taken at Blanchard about 1941. Lived there about 2 years.
13. **LaCenter, Clark Co., WA.** They moved from Blanchard to Wash. the Winter of 1942-43. It was after Lester went in the service on Oct 15 1942 and before Albert was born in Sept 1943. Lee R. came out to work in the Shipyards, he had experience with machinery that was needed. They came out on the train.
