C.R.O.P.S.**

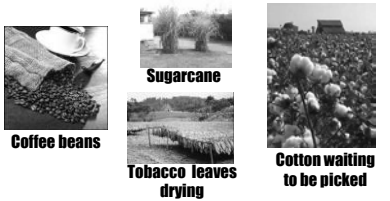


**C. Cash crops grown in Americas**
