Registration for grades 1-6 religious education classes will be held August 6, 2008 at 6:00 p.m. These classes will meet the second Saturday of each month from 8:00 am-12:00 pm during the '08-'09 school year. The fee for this registration is \$15 for the first child and \$10 for each additional child in a family. Participation in this program (or a comparable one) is required for children preparing for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Communion. This registration will be the only one for both Christ the King and St. Charles Borromeo campuses.

Registration for **First Reconciliation** and **First Communion** will be held also on **August 6, 2008**, immediately after the religious education registration. Candidates for these sacraments must be currently enrolled in our religious education program or a comparable program, must be at least in second grade, and must show readiness for these sacraments. Parents are to pay a book fee of \$12.50 for each sacrament, to complete a registration form, and to provide a copy of the child's baptismal certificate in order to be enrolled for the sacramental preparation. Originals of baptismal certificates will not be accepted.

Catholic Relief Services is supporting the emergency response of the Caritas Internationalist Network in Myanmar. Next Sunday our parish will have a 2nd Collection to send financial assistance for victims of Cyclone Nargis (hurricane) in Myanmar.

GRADUATION ADDRESS

In this season of graduations, we have an ancient model for a brilliant graduation address. Moses exhorts the people of Israel to take the words of God--the commandments--to heart and make an earnest effort to pass them on to succeeding generations. This message applies to us as well. Superficial knowledge of the Lord's words will not do. To say over and over "Lord, Lord!" or "Yes, Lord!" while doing nothing is all too common, even today.

And Paul does not contradict Moses when he says that we are justified by faith apart from observance of the law. If we have faith in the Lord, then we love the Lord. Out of that love we will want to know God's will and act in accord with God's every word. Jesus' great love for us brings justification entirely out of proportion to the sins of those who have faith in the Lord and try to keep God's word.
