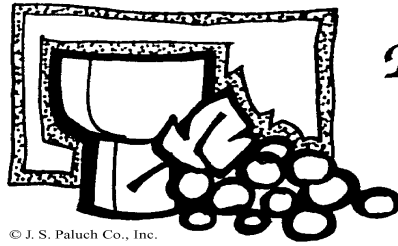
Theology on Tap at Tsunami:
